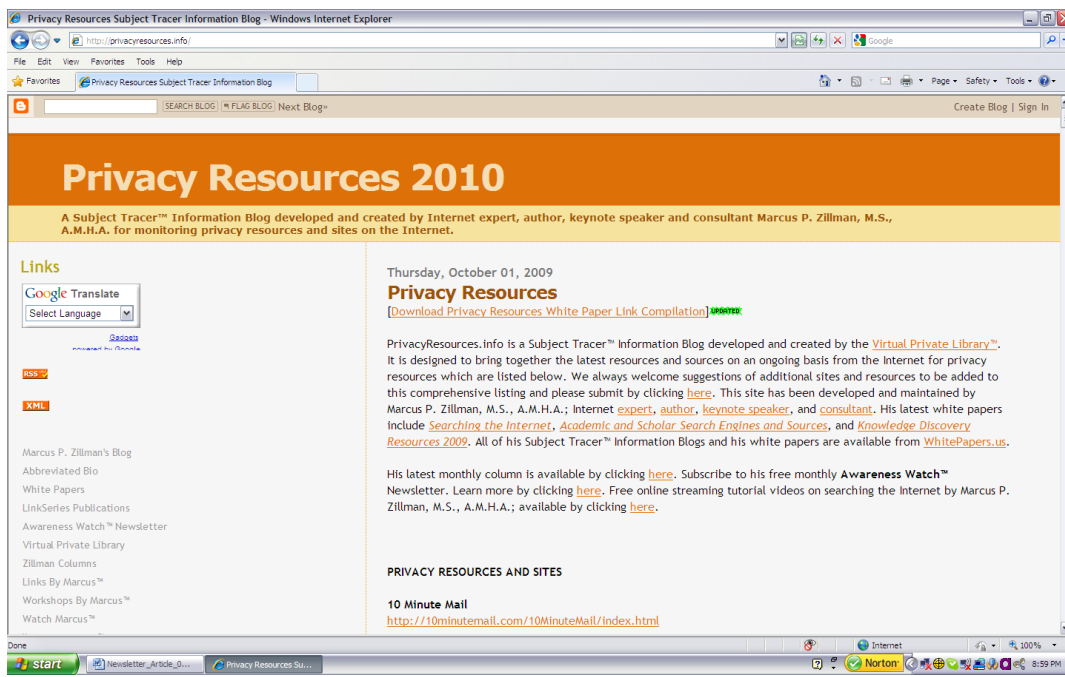

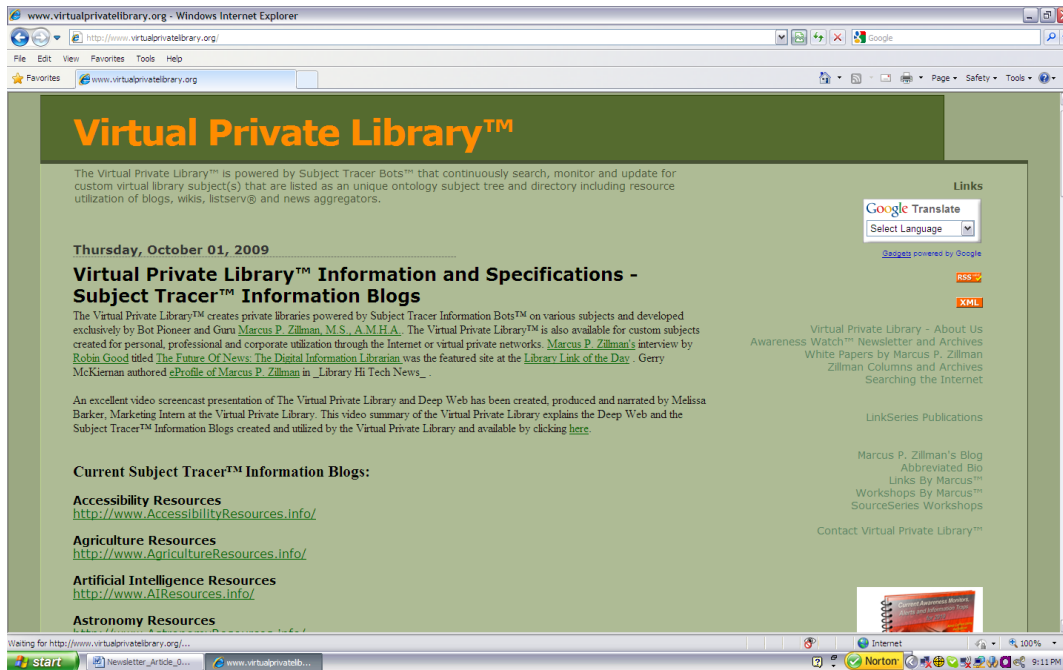


Figure 2: Virtual Private Library™
