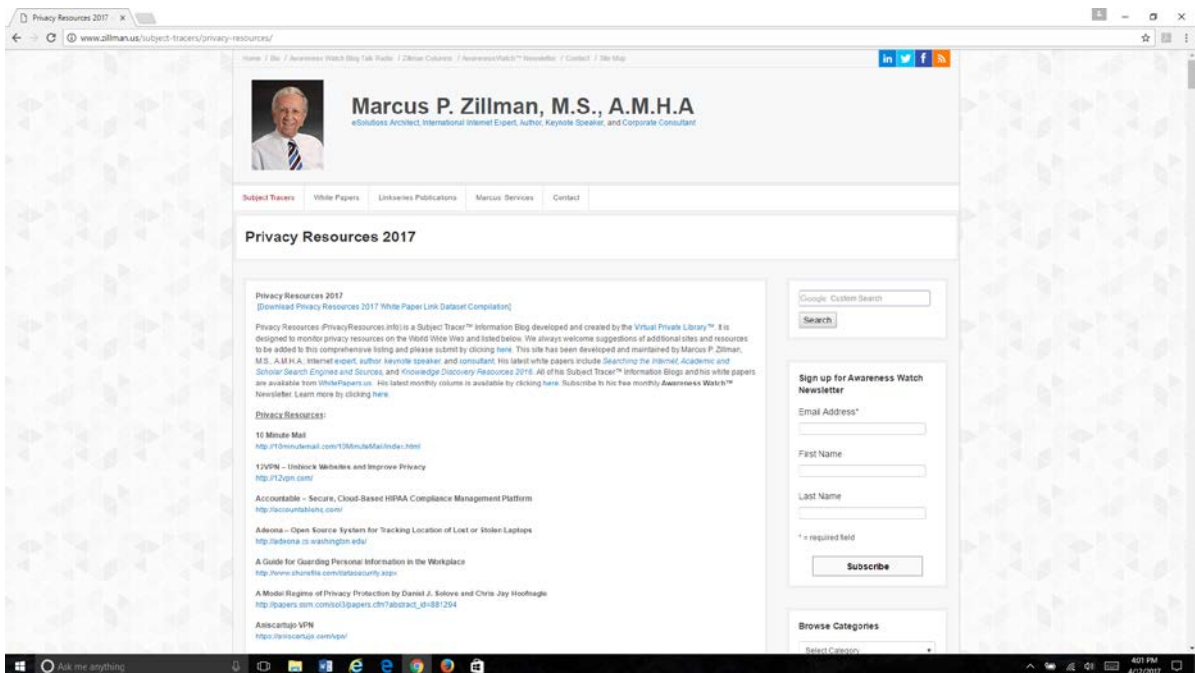


Figure 1: Privacy Resources 2017

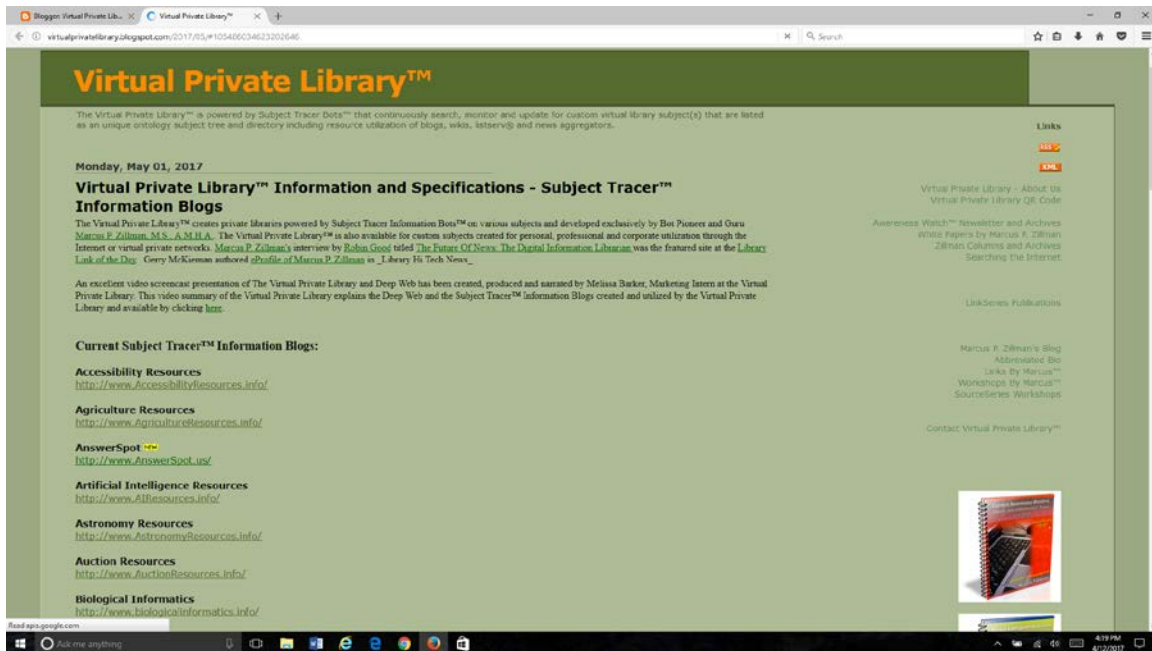


Figure 2: Virtual Private Library™
